The **SSI "Institute of Educational Analytics"** is a leading state scientific institution in Ukraine specialising in the development of educational statistics and information analytics. The Institute is a relatively young organisation that was established in 2014. It has about 80 employees, including researchers with academic degrees, leading experts, analysts and an important part of the team are IT specialists.

The Institute operates under the **Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine**. The main goal of the Institute is to provide reliable information and analytical support to the Ministry in the formation and implementation of state policy in the field of education.

- The Institute of Educational Analytics serves as the **information and analytical back office for the Ministry**, making effective use of modern IT tools and data science methods.
- It also provides technical administration for the national **education management information systems (EMIS)**, which are continuously scaled up and modernised with new applications.



Main information tools for education management used by the Institute of Educational Analytics, including those developed during the war

1. Official educational statistics (collection, verification, safe storage, distribution)

2. Verification and use of individual information about students and teachers for the needs of budget expenditures

3. Targeted surveys of the educational process participants to identify their urgent needs in extreme conditions (including in cooperation with foreign colleagues as UNICEF, World Bank, etc.)

4. Collection every 10 days of more than 100 indicators of administrative educational information from regions of Ukraine (Ministry dashboard)

5. Indicators based on operational data: a set of educational indicators important for management; risk-oriented visualization

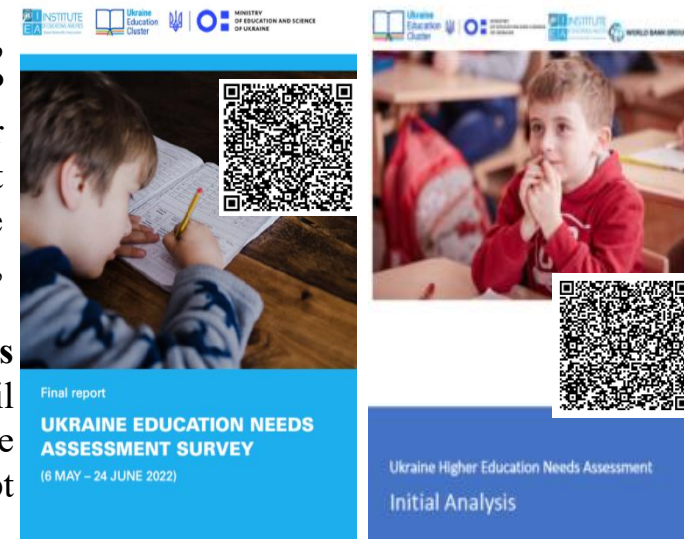

creation of a secure database of individual data of teachers and students for more accurate distribution of budget educational subventions (data are used to model the distribution of educational subventions, which account for about a third of all education budget expenditures, especially given the circumstances of a 20% reduction in budget in 2022/2023 compared to the previous year).

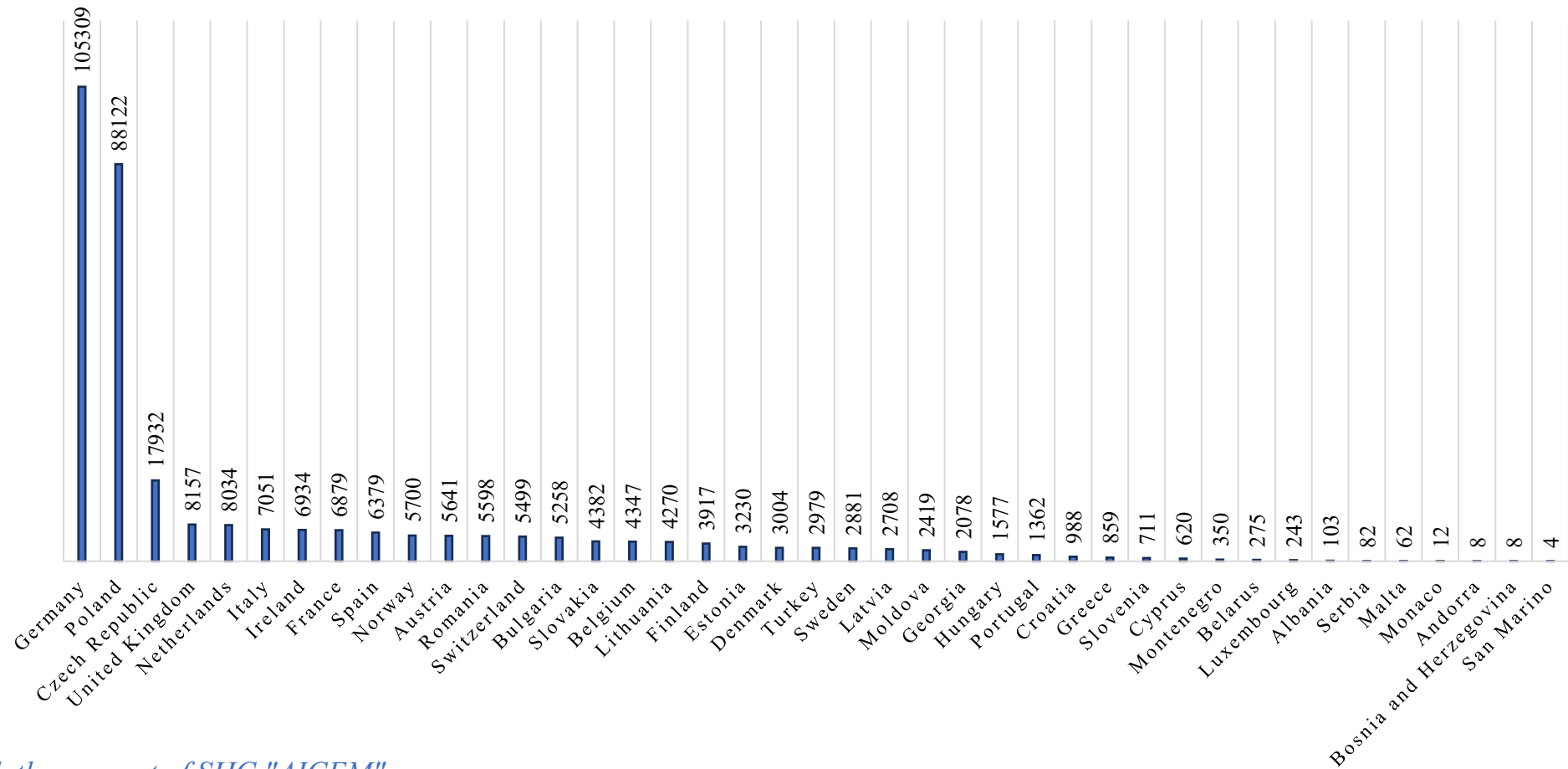
based on the results of these surveys, UNICEF financed \$80 for each of the IDP teachers and provided funds for laptops for them; 5 million computers with Microsoft licenses, 50 thousand Google licenses were distributed and administered to IDP teachers, etc.

during the war, administrative data is regularly collected from regional military-civil administrations, including from regions where hostilities take place, which allows for a prompt response to war-related educational problems.

Indicators based on operational data, created by the experts of the Institute of Educational Analytics together with the Ministry, are designed to present the key characteristics of the educational process both at the regional and national levels in the form of a thermal matrix in order to prioritize the areas of management efforts for the educational development.



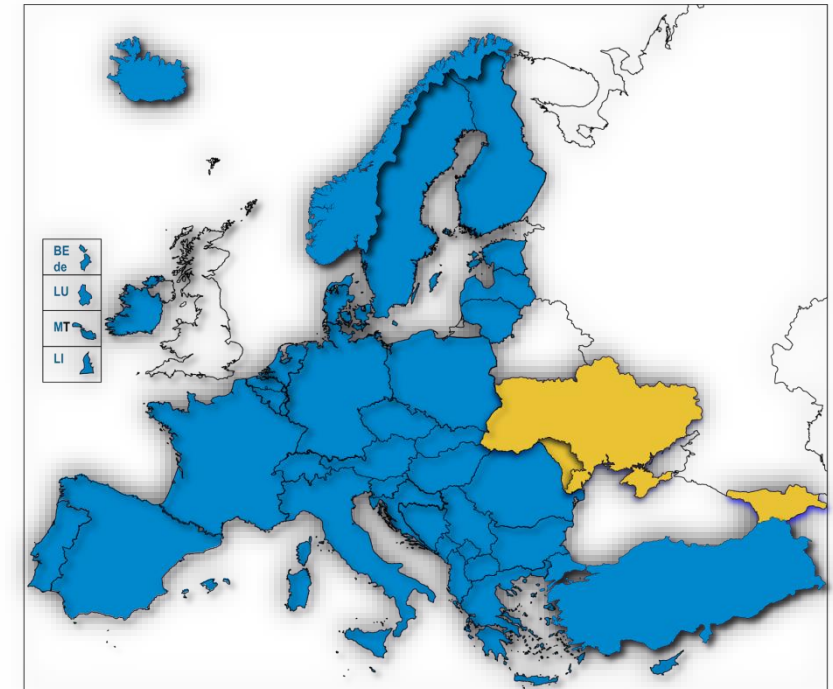
Distribution of **Ukrainian secondary school students** forced to leave as a result of the full-scale war (as of January 2025)

Eurydice National Unit in Ukraine: Establishment and Projects

- On 15 June 2023, the **Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine signed a framework agreement with the European Commission** on cooperation in the field of education, paving the way for closer alignment with the EU. This was an important step towards Ukraine's official accession to Eurydice Network in 2024.
- In 2024, the Network expanded to include three new countries – Ukraine, Georgia and Moldova. **In Ukraine, the SSI "Institute of Educational Analytics" was designated as the National Unit of the Eurydice Network** (Order of the Ministry of Education and Science No. 421 of 29.03.2024).

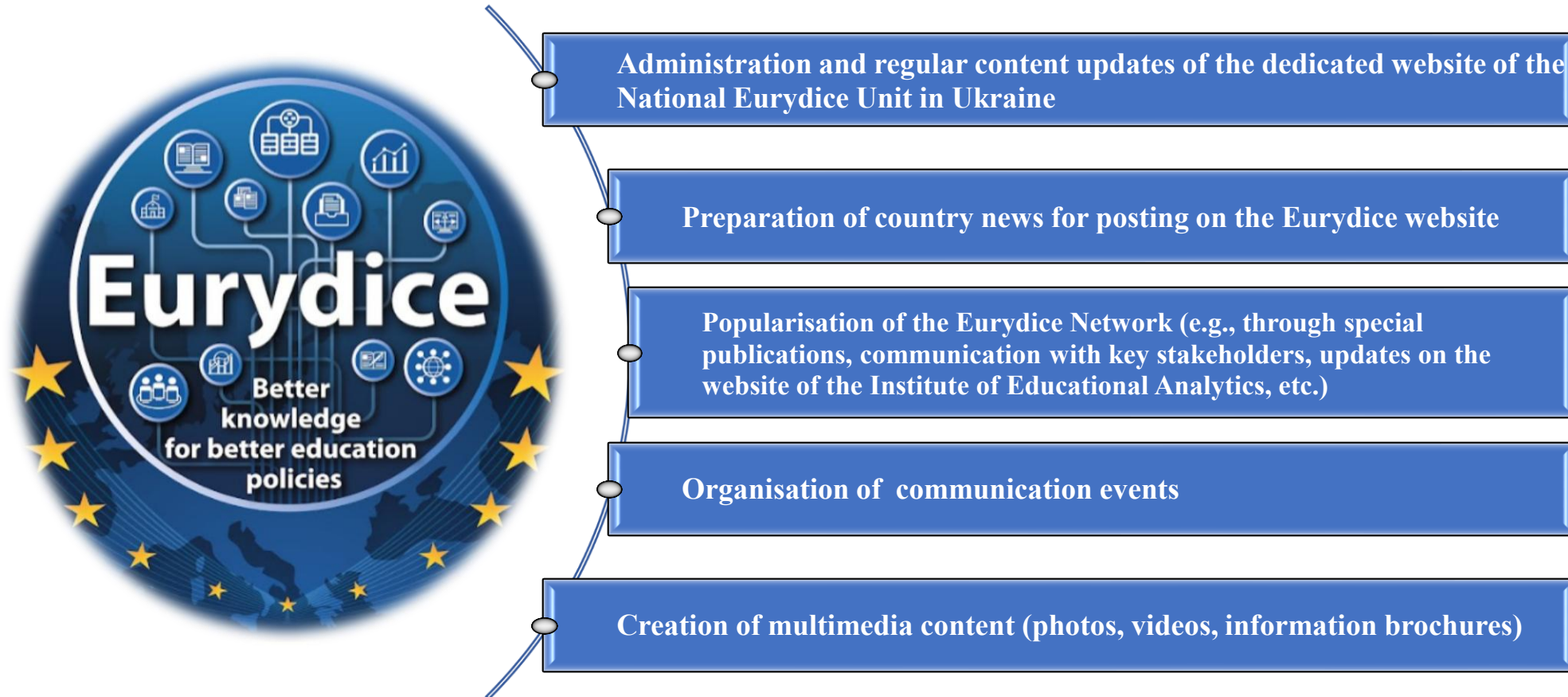

The reform of specialised secondary education is part of the comprehensive renewal of general secondary education envisaged by the "New Ukrainian School" concept. Starting in 2023/2024, this reform is to be completed over a decade, with the final phase expected between 2029 and 2033.

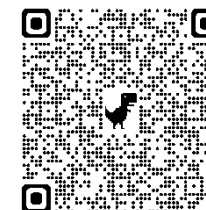
Ukraine: **Digital transformation of education** as a strategic path to resilience and innovation

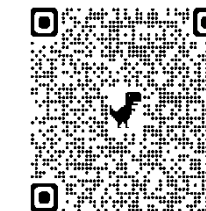
Ukraine: **Recognition of schoolchildren's learning outcomes acquired abroad** is now regulated

In June 2025, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine adopted a resolution approving the procedure for recognising the learning outcomes of schoolchildren who have received formal and/or non-formal education from providers located abroad. Based on legislative amendments adopted in February 2025, this document establishes such an official specific recognition mechanism for the first time.



Ukraine: **National educational platform supports reintegration and training of veterans**

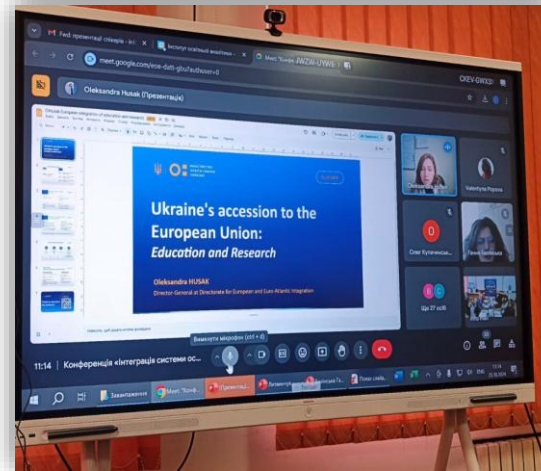
As a result of Russia's full-scale war against Ukraine, a substantial portion of the working-age population has been mobilised into the Armed Forces. The transition of service members back into civilian life requires comprehensive state support, particularly in the field of education. To support this transition, it is crucial to develop tools that offer opportunities for acquiring new knowledge, retraining and career development.

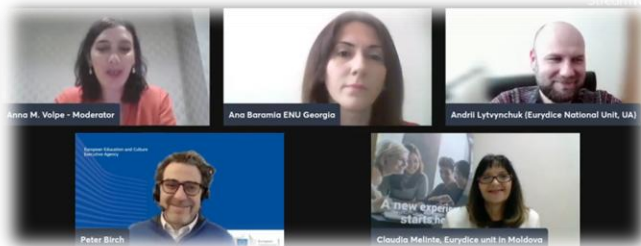

- In the **medium term**, an increase in cooperation between the Ukrainian National Unit and key stakeholders in the national and European educational space is anticipated
- In the **long term**, a mechanism for sharing best practices and conducting joint research to improve the quality of the education system and implement evidence-based policy reforms will be introduced.
